The Goodwill Youth & Young Adults Second Chance program aids young individuals returning to the Gary region. Referrals can also come from the judicial or justice systems.

If you are acquainted with someone who has a criminal history and is seeking help in determining a career trajectory, we encourage you to visit our office or schedule an appointment.

Eligible participants must:

- Be at least 15 years old and not older than 24 years of age on the date of enrollment.
- Reside in Gary, Indiana
- Have been expelled from a school OR had juvenile or adult justice system contact.

THE GOALS OF SECOND CHANCE ARE TO:

- Increase conflict resolution skills and develop strategies to prevent and avoid violence.
- · Introduce and prepare for the world of work.
- Identify career interests, attain relevant skills and gain work experience.

- Resume and Cover Letter Assistance


